Stanley Falkow has been called “father” of the field of microbial pathogenesis. A member of the US National Academy of Sciences and Foreign Fellow of the Royal Society, he received many awards: the Abbott Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Society for Microbiology, the Selman A. Waksman Award in Microbiology from the US National Academy of Sciences, the Lasker Award for Medical Research and the National Medal of Science from President Obama. He was also President of the American Society for Microbiology in 1997-98. His scientific accomplishments shine alongside his enthusiasm for teaching and mentoring students.
